## Winemaker Notes:

**The 2010 Vintage**: The growing season was favorable but a cool Spring delayed ripening but a warm Fall allowed us to pick in early November, a little late for our region.

**The Wine:** One of the most difficult challenges for any Winemaker due to extremely dark, tannic skins and small berries. Dense black color with classic 'pencil-lead' nose and great depth / abundant soft fruit scents with multiple aromas / deep flavor of ripe fruit and full palate feel with exciting Petite Verdot varietal depth / classic 'lavender' impression and an extraordinarily long finish of delicious and balanced depths.
